



Have you just arrived from another country and you would like to study?

If you are older than 16 years of age... *let's see what you can do*

How and where can I have my qualifications officially recognised?

By filling in the application form at the Department of Education's territorial delegations, to do so you must go to the **Zuzenean** offices

1. Print and sign the application form. (Prior paperwork online at the Department of Education's territorial delegation)
2. Proof of online payment.
3. Original document and photocopy of registration on municipal census.
4. Original document and photocopy of identity card.
5. Certified legal and translated photocopy of the academic qualifications that you wish to have officially recognised.



Important

You must present the original documents and the photocopies in order for them to be certified.

How and where should I enrol for studying?

Pre-enrolment. This takes place between April and May online or in the centre where you wish to study. For booking a place:

- Fill in the application form.
- Present a copy of your identity card or passport.
- Register on the municipal census: It is advisable to be registered on the municipal census.

Enrolment: this takes place in the month of July in the centre where you have been granted a place.

Enrolment outside the regular period: At the Territorial Delegations of the Basque Government's Department of Education.

REMEMBER! The school year begins in September and finishes in June. In order to be able to study you must enrol before the course begins, if not you must wait until the following course begins.

If you wish to enrol outside the regular period, you must apply through your corresponding Territorial Delegation of the Department of Education.

ESO COMPULSORY SECONDARY EDUCATION

16 years old

Prior official recognition of the qualifications awarded to you in your country. Enrol in a secondary school during the stipulated period or if you are not within the regular enrolment period, apply to the Department of Education's Territorial Delegation.

17 years old

In an adult education centre (EPA) from January or in schools during the regular enrolment period having received prior official recognition of your qualifications.

18+ years old

Apply to an adult education centre (EPA) where you can enrol for taking the Compulsory Secondary Education (ESO) qualification.

Basic Vocational Training Courses

The Basic Level Vocational Training qualification allows you to access the Intermediate Level Vocational Training courses

Intermediate Level Vocational Training Courses

The Intermediate Level Vocational Training qualification allows you to access the Higher Level Vocational Training and the Baccalaureate courses.

The Baccalaureate qualification allows you to access Higher Level Vocational Training or university courses
